BAND CAMP FEES

Please bring band fee (cash or check) on the **first day** of band camp.
Checks made payable to: *Northview Band and Orchestra Boosters.*

ALL WINDS AND AUXILIARY: \$40 (*cost includes: band t-shirt, uniform maintenance fee, & music*)

ALL PERCUSSIONISTS: \$60

(*cost includes either mallets, cymbal pads, sticks, drumhead/instrument maintenance, band t-shirt, uniform maintenance fee, & music*)

OPTIONAL PURCHASE:

Northview Band Baseball Cap! - \$15 – Choose from fitted or one-size-fits-all

Samples will be available the 1st day of camp

To be worn during games or as spirit wear!

Family can purchase for themselves as well!

SUPPLY LIST FOR EACH BAND STUDENT:

****Items #1-4 you will need for the FIRST day of band camp****

1. **Lyre & Flip Folder;** this holds the music outside. These items are specific to each instrument, so purchase the correct one.
2. **Slide Grease and Valve Oil;** this is needed for brass players only
3. **Box of Reeds & Cork Grease;** this is needed for woodwind players only
4. **Box of Pencils;** this is for rehearsals and can be kept in your band locker
5. **Dinkle Vangaurd Band Shoes;** (\$40.95 through Rettig music) We will use the shoes for both marching and concert bands. You might want to order a larger size so that you can use them for four years. (They will last that long!).

We do not collect money or order band shoes/accessories at school!!!

Concert Band members do not need to purchase the tuxedo shirt!

Kroger Community Rewards Program

If you have enrolled in the past, please re-enroll because enrollments drop off each year and you must re-enroll starting in April of each year for donations to continue.

Enrollment instructions:

STEP 1: Creating an Online Kroger Account

****NOTE: If you already have an online Kroger account, skip to STEP 2**

1. Go to www.krogercommunityrewards.com
2. Select "Create an Account".
3. Under Sign-In information, enter your email and create a password (write down your email and password – you will need it in Step 2)
4. Under "Select your preferred store" enter your postal code.
5. Select "Find Stores".
6. Choose your store from the drop down list and then Select "Create Account" (You will then get a message to check your email for a confirmation email. Click the link in the email message to finish creating your Online Kroger account.)
7. You will be prompted to add your Kroger Plus card to your account. Enter your Plus Card number and your last name.
8. Continue to Step 2.

STEP 2: Registering for the Kroger Community Rewards Program

1. Go to www.krogercommunityrewards.com
2. Select "Sign In".
3. Enter your email address and password and Select "Sign In" (this will be the email and password you created in Step 1)
4. Select "Community" then "Community Rewards" from the drop down list.
5. Under "Find Your Organization": Enter the NPO number 84885 or Northview Band & Orchestra then select "Search".
6. Under "Select Your Organization", select the Northview Band & Orchestra then select "Enroll".
7. You should now see Northview Band & Orchestra listed under "Community Rewards" on your account summary page.

ANYONE can register their Kroger Plus card to support our organization so tell your friends, family and neighbors to enroll too!

You must swipe your registered Kroger Plus card or use the phone number that is related to your registered Kroger Plus card when shopping for your purchases to count.
